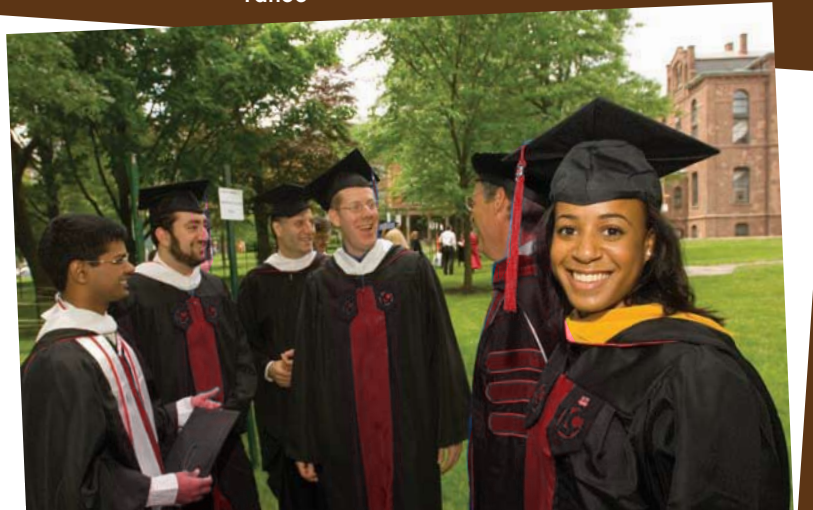

NEW BRUNSWICK/ PISCATAWAY SURVEY HIGHLIGHTS

- 16% response rate; 655 responses from 3,930 May graduates
- 87% of respondents consider their academic experience "excellent" or "good"
- 75% consider Career Services "excellent" or "good"
- 75% say their preparation for the future was "excellent" or "good"
- 71% used Career Services
- 15% plan to attend graduate school during the next academic year
- 55% report having a job at the time of graduation
- 65% of the jobs were in New Jersey; New York was second with 21%
- 90% of respondents report salaries of \$30,000 or higher
- 72% report salaries of \$40,000 or higher

Data for this report was also derived from the survey of graduates of the School of Arts & Science Honors Program
